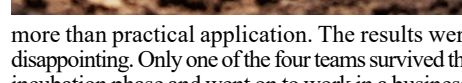


We found that these ideas worked best when they served what business founders were already trying to do, rather than when presented as a *separate* cause. And entrepreneurs responded best

We argue that the adoption of such practices, more generally, shouldn't require businesses, whether established or just starting up, to choose between profit and sustainability. Often, the two point in the same direction. When startup founders build products that last longer, recover more value from materials, and reduce dependence on fragile supply chains, they often create a more robust

Our first cohort looked promising on paper, consisting of eighteen recruited participants with formal knowledge of business and sustainability. We then assigned them to specific waste sectors, such as polyester waste, divided among four teams. Our trainings relied on lectures and presentations
